
GIRLS OF BPS GOVT. MEDICAL COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, KHANPUR KALAN OUTSHINES IN FIRST PROF. EXAMINATION IN ALL THE GOVT. MEDICAL COLLEGES OF HARYANA

University of Health Sciences, Rohtak on 29.8.2014 (Friday) declared the result of First Professional MBBS Annual Examination for the session 2013-14. BPS Govt. Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan beats all the Government Medical Colleges running in the State as Miss Aditya secured first position by securing 74.6% marks, Miss Monika Verma secured second position by securing 73.3% marks and Miss Leenakshi secured third position by securing 73% marks.

Overall pass percentage of the BPS Govt. Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan is 95% whereas the pass percentage of other Government Medical Colleges is: PGIMS, Rohtak 81.5%, Saheed Hasan Khan Mewati Govt. Medical College, Mewat 79% and Maharaja Aggrasen Medical College, Agroha 91%. The annual intake of students in PGIMS, Rohtak is 200 whereas in BPS Govt. Medical College for Women, Saheed Hasan Khan Mewati Govt. Medical College, Mewat and Maharaja Aggrasen Medical College, Agroha is 100. 87% students of BPS Govt. Medical College for Women secured more than 60% marks as compared to PGIMS, Rohtak 46%, Saheed Hasan Khan Mewati Govt. Medical College, Mewat 46% and Maharaja Aggrasen Medical College, Agroha 14%. 17% students of the BPS Govt. Medical College for Women and one student from PGIMS, Rohtak secured more than 70% marks. It is pertinent to mention here that the BPS Govt. Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan is the first Govt. Medical College for women after independence which was started in the year 2011.
